


## **Logistics Park Phoenix Newsletter: Tracking for Success**

As part of our commitment to community engagement, we recently requested a

### BNSF has been part of Arizona's history for over a century, and our commitment to the state's growth is stronger than ever. From our early days establishing roots in

Wickenburg with a wooden depot station, to operating the Southern Transcon—one of the busiest freight corridors in the U.S. today—we've played a key role in Arizona's transportation network. As the Phoenix metropolitan area has experienced tremendous growth, BNSF has been diligently preparing for over two decades to expand its rail footprint to meet the

increasing demand. In 2004, BNSF acquired more than 800 acres, the original LPP

property, in northwest Maricopa County to accommodate future rail requirements including the long-planned intermodal facility. The possibility of a new railyard near Surprise was noted in the 2011 Arizona State Rail Plan. As growth in the region continued to exceed expectations, BNSF modified its strategic plans to respond to the needs of the market and developed plans for a unified, master-planned rail and logistics campus. The Logistics Park Phoenix

concept is a multi-billion-dollar transportation solution for Arizona, which will house

the long-planned Intermodal Facility, a Logistics Park and Logistics Center. In March 2022, BNSF acquired 3,500 acres of State Trust land to add to its existing 800 acres. BNSF acquired the additional property through a lengthy public process. In Arizona, State Trust lands, which are not public land, were set aside at statehood to create a dedicated revenue source to support education. State Trust lands are sold at public auction for fair market value, which is determined by an independent appraisal approved by the State Land Department's Board of Appeals. The mission of the State Land Department is to manage the State's Land Trust to generate maximum revenues through prudent planning decisions for the benefit of

K-12 schools and higher education. Acquisition of this land helped fulfill the goals of the State Land Trust and paved the way for BNSF to make a legacy investment in Arizona and develop the flagship Logistics Park Phoenix project to serve the needs of the growing Phoenix market. BNSF's plans for Logistics Park Phoenix were highlighted in the 2022 Arizona State Rail Plan as a prime spot for rail services. And once Logistics Park Phoenix is complete, we'll continue supporting Arizona's economy and its schools through ongoing tax revenue, helping to invest in the state's future.
